I have special experience in performing abdominal ultrasound as well. I also do endoscopy lists of

both diagnostic and therapeutic upper and lower GI endoscopy since September 2014 till present, at a rate of about 2 lists per week (about 10 patients per list approximately).

I'm a registrar of general and transplant hepatology at Al-Rajhy liver hospital, where we perform liver transplants since November 2014 as it is the only centre for liver transplantation in Upper Egypt. We also treat complex cases of hepato-biliary and pancreatic diseases, as well as management of chronic liver conditions including HCV and HBV.

- **Trainee – (January to August 2014):** A trainee for 6 months starting from January 2014, in the field of LDLT in liver transplant unit at Ain Shams centre for organ transplantation (ASCOT), Cairo, Egypt, which is the largest centre for liver transplantation in Egypt. A good experience was obtained about the selection, preoperative assessment and postoperative management and follow up for patients undergoing living donor liver transplantation.
- **Visiting clinical fellow - (17/2/2015 to 1/8/2015):** at Queen Elizabeth hospital Birmingham (QEHB), United Kingdom, which is considered one of the largest centers of liver transplantation in the UK. There I got a great experience in the complex pre and postoperative evaluation and management of liver transplant cases, along with a wonderful practical experience about the new therapies for HCV.
