The hospital contains 2027 beds, including 94 ICU beds, and 46 operative theaters in which 240 operations are performed daily. 1478 medical and 6428 paramedical staff serve in this hospital. 3000 patients visit the outpatient clinics and 1000 are received in the emergency departments daily. The department of General Surgery contains 420 beds, including 98 beds in six specialized units: Laparoscopic Surgery unit, Pediatrics Surgery unit, Facio-maxillary surgery unit, Emergency Surgery unit, Endoscopy unit (including ERCP).
