Clinical Experiences

Assiut University Hospitals, Assiut, Egypt (March 2004 – December 2013):

Assiut University Hospital is the biggest hospital in Upper Egypt & is the third biggest in the whole country (> 1800 bed) with continuous expansion. The Department of Internal Medicine consists of > 160 beds including:

- Cardiology unit (20 beds), Cardiology Intensive care unit (CCU) (10 beds), Stress ECG & Echocardiography units.
- Nephrology unit (20 beds) & Dialysis unit (30 machines).
- Hepatology & Gastroentrology unit (24 beds), Gastoentrology intermediate care unit (12 beds).
- Hematology unit (20 beds), Hematology intermediate care unit (8 beds).
- Rheumatology unit (10 beds).
- Endocrinology unit (20 beds).
- General Medicine unit (20 beds).

During my job in this department, I have worked as a house officer (Intern) for 4 months and as a senior house officer (resident doctor) for 3 years.

My clinical duties included outpatient clinic sessions (new & follow-up patients), ward rounds, 2-3 shifts per week (each lasting 24 hours, taking care of newly admitted & emergency cases). I have participated in medical seminars, journal clubs, case presentations, conferences & clinical research projects.

The post was rotational between the different units every 3 or 4 months. The team would

generally consist of one professor (consultant), one lecturer (senior registrar), one assistant lecturer (registrar), and one senior house officer (resident). I had the chance to deal with hundreds of cases in the following specialties:

- Hematology Unit: I had worked in hematology unit for 2 years and during that period I had the chance to deal with large numbers of cases including management and follow up of:
 - All types of anaemias including:
 - o Iron deficiency anaemia.
 - Macrocytic anaemias.
 - Hemolytic anaemia.
 - Thalassemia and hemoglobinopathies.
 - Marrow damage anaemias.
 - Dysplastic and sideroblastic anaemia.
 - Polycythaemia.
 - Acute myeloid and acute lymphoblastic leukemia.
 - Chronic myeloid leukemia.
 - Chronic lymphocytic leukemia.
 - Hodgkin's and Non Hodgkin's lymphomas.
 - Myeloproliferative disorders.
 - Multiple myeloma and other plasma cell disorders.
 - All types of bleeding disorders including:
 - Vascular purpura.
 - Thrombocytopenia and platelet dysfunction.
 - o Hemophilia.
 - Consumptive coagulopathies.
 - Thrombotic disorders.
 - All kinds of hematological emergencies.
- Hepatology & Gastroentrology Unit: I had the chance to deal with patients with liver & gastrointestinal diseases including cases of GIT bleeding, hepatic coma & fulminant hepatic failure.
- Endocrinology & Diabetes Unit: I had the chance to deal with cases of diabetes & its complications and other endocrine disorders including endocrine emergencies.

- **Nephrology Unit:** I had the chance to deal with cases of acute & chronic renal failure & their complications.
- **Rheumatology unit:** I had the chance to deal with cases of connective tissue diseases including their complications & complications of steroid therapy.
- **Cardiology unit:** I had the chance to deal with cases of chest pain, acute coronary syndromes, arrhythmias, rheumatic heart diseases, cardiac arrest & cardiopulmonary resuscitation.
- Emergency Department: I had the chance to deal with various kinds of emergencies.
