The hospital contains 2027 beds, including 94 ICU beds, and 46 operative theaters in which 240 operations are performed daily. 1478 medical and 6428 paramedical staff serving in this hospital. 3000 patients visit the outpatient clinics and 1000 are received in the emergency departments daily. The department of Otorhinolaryngology contains 40 beds.
