SUMMARY OF CLINICAL EXPERIENCE:

The Internship Period (01/03/2008 till 28/02/2009):

It was divided into two months in each of the following departments: general surgery, internal medicine, pediatrics, gynecology and obstetrics, cardiology and emergency. By the end of the Pre- Registration period, the Egyptian Medical Syndicate registered me.

The Residency Period (01/03/2009 till 7/2012):

I started my Anesthesia career since Mars, 2009 beginning with three years extensive Anesthesia residency training program in Assiut University Hospitals with average working hours of around 70 hours per week. During it, I was assigned to work for 25 days/month, which included 12 -14 days as full day duty including night shifts. During that period, I gained extensive hand on experience in anesthesia, ICU, and postoperative pain management.

Clinical Fellow and Assistant Lecturer Periods (2012 till 2018):

Afterwards, I worked as an Assistant lecturer/specialist in Assiut University Hospitals also for about 6 years to get more experience in advanced anaesthesia subspecialties and intensive care medicine based on the best evidence. During this period, I was assigned to work for 22days/month, which including 10 days as a full duty with night shifts. In addition to the previous residency activities, it included training in cardiac and neuroanaesthesia and different pain intervention and nerve block. I believe that I've got a special opportunity to collect the appropriate advanced training and experience in both Anaesthesia and ICU to help myself to become a professional anaesthetist and intensivist.

ICU work:

Taking regular rotations in each of the five intensive care units: General ICU, Postoperative ICU, Trauma ICU, Obstetric ICU and Pediatric cardiac surgery unit. (Usually 3 Assistant lectures are responsible for each ICU for 3 to 4 months). The Assistant lecturer acts as a team leader during the on-call time deputizing the teaching staff / Consultant and responsible for following up the clinical management plan, supervising the residents and supporting them with all training skills and clinical decisions.

Dealing with different varieties of ICU cases e.g. respiratory failure patients, post-operative patients after major vascular, orthopaedic, laryngeal and neurosurgery and cardiac surgery, critically ill patients (acute severe asthma, pulmonary edema, heart failure, cerebrovascular stroke, poisoning,

eclampsia and preeclampsia, hepatic coma, etc.), polytrauma patients and shocked patients etc. with good experience in handling different modes of mechanical ventilation.

Anaesthesia work:

Taking 5 operative lists per week including Anaesthesia subspecialties (neurosurgery, cardiac surgery, pediatric anasethesia).

Taking one to two Anaesthesia on call duties per week for surgical emergencies. I have an excellent experience in most of the Anaesthesia subspecialties.

The average operative lists achieved by the whole anaesthetic team in our hospital per week include:

- Plastic surgery (average of 40 cases)
- Vascular surgery (average of 15-20 cases)
- Neurosurgery (average of 15-20 cases)
- Cardiothoracic surgery (average of 10 cases)
- ENT and Ophthalmic surgery (average of 40 cases)
- Orthopedic and Arthroscopic surgery (average of 100 cases)
- Obstetrics and Gynaecological surgery (average of 15-20 cases)
- Genitourinary tract surgery (average of 50 cases)
- General Surgery (average of 50 cases)
- Endoscopic Surgery (average of 15-20 cases)
- Pediatric Surgery (average of 40 cases)
- Microsurgery (average of 50 cases)

The department of anesthesia provides same standard care for patients outside main OR e.g. Cardiac catheterization lab (mostly for interventional diagnostic & Therapeutic procedures for babies with congenital heart defects), Interventional Radiology procedures (coiling of cerebral aneurysms), GI endoscopies, CT scan, MRI, ESWL, and Dental procedures.

HINT ABOUT ASSIUT UNIVERSITY HOSPITALS:

Assiut University Hospital is the largest Hospital in South Egypt. Serving more than 3 million people in Upper Egypt. It has a capacity of more than 2000 beds, 5 Intensive Care Units (general (25) beds, post-operative (12) beds, trauma (25) beds, obstetric (12) beds and paediatric postoperative cardiac and general (10) beds), a high dependency unit for head injured patients, and a Chronic Pain Clinic. It also has a CT, MRI, Echo, Dialysis, Coronary and Special Care Baby Unit. Separate hospitals for women and children. There is also a centre for microsurgery which is well recognised worldwide, receiving patients from all over Egypt for various types of operations; vascularized fibular graft, free muscle flap, correction of Erb's palsy, which is unfortunately not uncommon in our country, reimplantation of amputated limbs or fingers, etc. Recently, two big centres started their services for cardiac and hepatic patients (liver center with a specialized unit for liver transplantation and cardiac centre providing almost all kinds of treatment either medical, catheter based or surgical interventions for all cardiac patients. We also have two separate hospitals for neurosurgery and neurology and urology.

SCIENTIFIC AND ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES:

 Participate in postgraduate teaching program, case presentations and journal clubs at Anaesthesia department, Assiut University Hospitals, Assiut-Egypt Responsible for teaching and training Anaesthesia and ICU interns, residents and junior staff in operative rooms and ICU rounds at faculty of medicine, Assiut University Hospitals, Assiut- Egypt from 01/3/2009 till now.
