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Definition of code of ethics

The **code of ethics** is a set of higher values that the faculty seeks to abide by in order to achieve its mission. It defines the rules that must be met by each of the faculty members, their assistants, administrators, workers and students.

- Creating a scientific and psychological climate and encouraging excellence and distinction.

- Dealing fairly and equitably with professors, students and employees. Setting exams and evaluating students to combat cheating.
- Efficient use of available resources.

- Directing teachers and workers to serve the community.
- Integrity in presenting reports on the evaluation of faculty members.

Ethics of the university professor towards the teaching profession

- Mastery of the material entrusted with teaching and good preparation for the material.
 - Create opportunities among students to achieve the highest level in the examination.
- Clarify the course framework, objectives, contents, and evaluation and review methods.
- Using teaching time well and respecting the student's ability to think.
 - To be a model of democratic values.
 - Refrain from giving private lessons.

 - Demonstrate decent morals and respect for his colleagues.
 - Avoiding suspicions and not intolerance of opinions.
