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Field training concept

It is a means of communication that provides the opportunity for the student to gain experiences and knowledge through watching reality and getting to know the facts on the ground, and thus this experience becomes

Field visit

lasting

It is one of the means of field training that relates to witnessing the service institutions in reality through visual vision by going to those institutions at a predetermined and agreed upon date.

Field training objectives

- Acquiring new knowledge and skills to achieve an appropriate understanding of the subject matter.
- Giving students the correct thinking and scientific research approach by conducting theoretical research related to the field that will be visited before making the visit.
- Develop students' critical thinking and

- innovation through their criticism and suggestions after visiting the institution or working for it.
- The field visit allows students to work within a team, which develops their attitude towards cooperation and democracy.

Basis for selecting field visit institutions

- Linking the curriculum with students' life experiences.
- Analyze realistic problems and solve them properly.
- The training experience should be commensurate with the student's previous experiences and abilities.
 - Provide equal training opportunities for all students and develop independence.

Principles of field training

- The commitment of the management of institutions and the specialists working in them to accept the idea that the field visit is one of the important functions of the institution.
- The presence of an official, provided that the institution allows him the necessary time to meet the students and give them information about the institution and respond to their inquiries.
- The presence of customers who benefit from the institution at the time of visiting students.
- facilities and capabilities for students to visit, and facilitates actual viewing and passing through the various departments of the institution.
