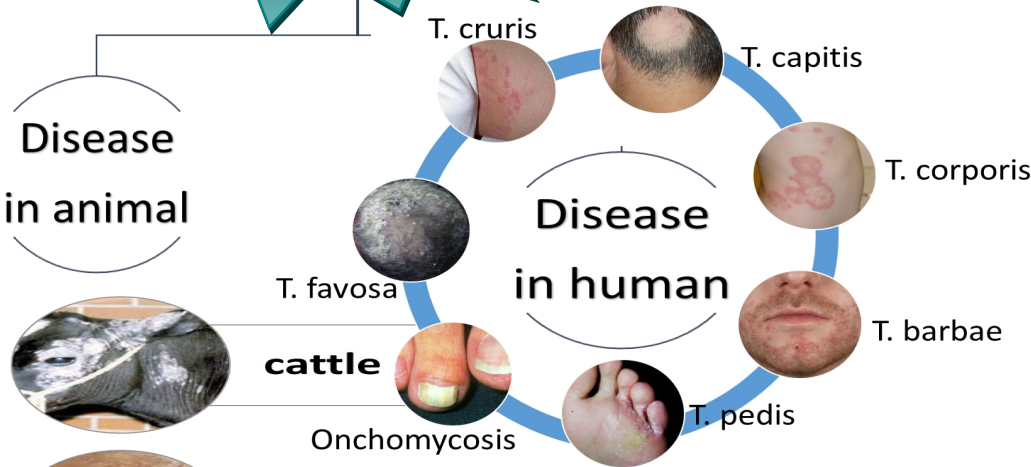

<p>DO: Wash your hands after touching or petting animals</p>	<p>DON'T: Share towels, sports gears or other personal items.</p>
<p>DO: Change your socks and undergarments, everyday</p>	<p>Ringworm:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Spreads from other people, animals and contaminated surfaces. Is known by other names, like "athlete's foot" or "jock itch" Needs to be treated with antifungal medicine
